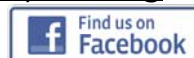

- **Branding/Marketing & Technology Committee:** Engage the membership and community through media outreach and within 9 months brand CBTU so that its message appeals to workers of all ages and the community.
- **CARAT Programs Committee: (Community Action and Response against Toxics):** Recognizing the compelling need for ethnic minorities to have access to information about toxic chemicals and the strategic role that trade unionists can play in this process, the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists initiated the CARAT Team. CARAT Teams are a network of local environmental justice alliances whose mission is to empower workers and residents to work together to promote environmental quality in African American and other minority communities.
- **Education Committee: Outreach & Engagement:** Outreach and Member education and engagement so that members will be able to articulate the CBTU mission and goals and develop self-interest rationale for membership in CBTU.
- **Financial Resources Committee:** Increase the financial stability of CBTU and ensure longevity through on-going funding activities.
- **Men's Committee programs Committee:** The committee is based on a simple principle, through sustained mentoring programs, implementing and promoting mentoring as a critical transformative vehicle in the lives of youth health. We use our network to deliver programs at the annual Men's Regional conference. We engage in programs in our communities and union.
- **New Organizing Committee / Outreach & Engagement Goal:** To broaden the power and influence of CBTU by increasing community outreach initiatives, engaging membership in education and promoting chapter expansion.
- **Political Action Committee:** Expand member awareness, knowledge, and ability to participate in political engagement activities and political processes demonstrated by increased CBTU members identified as actively involved in chapter and local political campaigns.
- **Women's Committee:** Engages in outreach programs that bring awareness to education issues, domestic violence, politics, and leadership development and health issues facing women of color. We have an annual conference with workshops that focus on the needs of women in the trade union movement.
- **Young Workers (Under 40) Committee:** Increase by 25-30% young worker engagement and participation through mentoring, scholarships, and partnerships during Regional and National conferences.
